7) MY WALK 8) MY STAND ANYTIME: The Filling of the Holy Spirit**

1) THE BLOOD: Father God, I come to You through faith in the shed blood of Jesus Christ Your Son on the cross of Calvary. I confess my sin(s) of (walking in my sinful nature). Thank You that Your blood Jesus gives me forgiveness for my sins and power over my sin(s). Come into my heart now and be my Savior and Lord. Thank You Father God that I am Your child. I am forgiven, loved, accepted by God, & You are always with me.

2) DIED: Jesus thank You for dying on the cross for me. Jesus You showed Your love for me by dying on the cross. Your death brought death to my old sinful man. I am crucified with You Jesus and my body of sin is now rendered powerless. I am dead and free from sin.

3) BURIED: Jesus thank You that I was buried in You and that my old man is in the grave. Help me to leave my old sinful man there.

4) RESURRECTED: Jesus thank You that I arose in You and that I have Resurrection Life. I am a new creation and have new life in You Jesus – Resurrection Life!! The old has past the new has come.

5) ASCENDED: Jesus, thank You that I was ascended in You and I am above things of this earth.

6) SEATED: Jesus, thank You that I am now seated in the heavenly realms in You, Christ Jesus. Lord help me to live my life from this position of being seated in You in the heavenly realm. Then I am free from sin and Your power is strongest in my life.

7) MY WALK: Jesus I take my position of being seated in You and now ask You to give me power to live a life worthy of the calling I have received. As I walk with You fill me with Your Spirit. I want to walk as Jesus did

8) MY STAND: Jesus, I now STAND in You in my Christian life. I stand on Your promises, Your truth, Your power, and Your life. Thank You Jesus!!

FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT (can be prayed anytime!!): Jesus I am a member of Your Spiritual Church through faith in Your death and resurrection. Holy Spirit, come fall upon me now. Come fill me Holy Spirit in my spirit, my soul (mind–will–emotions), and through every cell in my body so I can serve You. Fill me Holy Spirit – I want more of You. Thank You Holy Spirit that I am sealed by You for the day of redemption. I am an anointed, blood bought, Spirit-filled, child of God. I am loved & accepted by God Almighty & free!!!!

BIBLE VERSES:

1) THE BLOOD: For the life of a creature is in the blood, and I have given it to you to make atonement for yourselves on the altar; it is the blood that makes atonement for one's life. (Lev.17:11) The blood will be a sign for you on the houses where you are, and when I see the blood, I will pass over you. No destructive plague will touch you when I strike Egypt. (Ex.12:13) Since we have now been justified by his **blood**, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through him! (Romans 5:9) In him we have redemption through his **blood**, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace (Ephesians 1:7) But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near by the **blood** of Christ. (Ephesians 2:13) and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his **blood**, shed on the cross. (Col.1:20)

2) DIED: For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body ruled by sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin—because anyone who has died has been set free from sin. (Romans 6:6-7) I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me. (Galatians 2:20)

3) BURIED: We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life. (Romans 6:4)

4) RESURRECTED: For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly also be united with him in a resurrection like his. (Romans 6:5)

5) ASCENDED: After he said this, he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight. (Acts 1:9) was taken up in glory. (Timothy 3:16)

6) SEATED: And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus, (Ephesians 2:6) Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, (Philippians 2:9)

7) MY WALK: (Ephesians 4:1) So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness. (Colossians 2:6-7)

8) MY STAND: Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. (Ephesians 6:13) Moses answered the people, "Do not be afraid. **Stand firm** and you will see the deliverance the LORD will bring you today. The Egyptians you see today you will never see again. (Exodus 14:13) then, free of fault, you will lift up your face; you will **stand firm** and without fear. (Job 11:15) because it is by faith you **stand firm.** (2 Cor.1:24)

FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT (can be prayed anytime!!): When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues¹ as the Spirit enabled them. (Acts 2:1-4) But very truly I tell you, it is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you. (John 16:7) Exalted to the right hand of God, he has received from the Father the promised Holy Spirit and has poured out what you now see and hear. (Acts 2:33)

(Rom. 12:5) I'm filled with joy & peace. I overflow with hope by the Holy Spirit's power (Rom 15:13) I am sanctified in Christ Jesus and called to be holy (1 Cor. 1:2) • I have been given grace in Christ Jesus. (1 Cor. 1:4) Because of God I am in Christ Jesus (1 Cor. 1:30) I am wise in Christ! (1 Cor. 4:10) I have ten thousand guardians in Christ, (1 Cor. 4:15) I am made alive in Christ Jesus. (1 Cor. 15:22) • I am washed, sanctified and justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ (1 Cor.6:11) • My body is the Holy Spirit's abode (1 Cor.6:19) • I have spiritual gifts (1 Cor.12:11) Christ's promises are always "Yes" in Christ. (2 Cor. 1:19--20) • God makes me stand firm in Christ. (2 Cor. 1:21) God has anointed me, set his seal of ownership on me. (2 Cor.1:21) God has put His Spirit in my heart as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come. (2 Cor.1:21) In Christ I have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins (Eph. 1:7-8) God's grace has been lavished on me with all wisdom and understanding (Eph. 1:7-8) I have been chosen and predestined in Christ (Eph.1:11) In Christ, I am a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come! (2 Cor. 5:17) God has reconciled me to Himself in Christ, (2 Cor. 5:19) – He has committed to me the message of reconciliation. (2 Cor.5:19) God made Him who had no sin to be sin for me, (2 Cor.5:21) In God I have become the righteousness of God. (2 Cor.5:21) Everything I do is for other's strengthening. (2 Cor.12:19) I have freedom in Christ Jesus and will not become a slave again to sin. (Gal 2:4) I have put my faith in Christ Jesus that I may be justified by faith in Christ (Gal. 2:16) I have been blessed in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing (Eph. 1:3) • I was chosen in Him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless (Eph. 1:4) I have been marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, (Eph.1:13) • God raised me up with Christ and seated me with Him in the heavenly realms (Eph. 2:6) I am God's workmanship. (Eph.2:10) • I'm created in Christ Jesus to do good works prepared in advance for me (Eph.2:10) • In Christ Jesus I have been brought near through the blood of Christ. (Eph. 2:13) In Christ I may approach God with freedom and confidence. (Eph. 3:12) • Christ dwells in my heart through faith. I'm being rooted and established in love. (Eph. 3:17) I've been forgiven in Christ. I should be kind and compassionate. (Eph. 4:32) • I should pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers/requests (Eph. 6:18) • I should be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints. (Eph.6:18) • I am a servant and saint in Christ Jesus (Phil. 1:1) I put no confidence in the flesh (Phil. 3:3) • I want to be found in Him, having God's righteousness by faith (Phil. 3:9) • I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus. (Phil. 3:14) • I have heavenly citizenship in Christ (Phil.3:20) My name is recorded in heaven (Phil. 4:3) The peace of God will guard my heart and mind in Christ Jesus. (Phil. 4:7) I am strengthened for all tasks to which God calls me (Phil.4:13) I have all my needs met according to His glorious riches in Christ Jesus (Phil. 4:19) I am a saint in Christ Jesus (Phil. 4:21) I am holy and faithful in Christ. God's given me grace and peace (Col. 1:2) I have been rescued from the dominion of darkness and brought into the kingdom of God's Son (Col.1:13) • In Christ, I have redemption, the forgiveness of sins. (Col. 1:14) • Christ is before all things, and in Him I am held together. (Col. 1:17) • All God's fullness dwells in me. I am complete in Him. (Col. 1:19) I have all the hidden treasures of wisdom and knowledge in Christ. (Col. 2:3) Just as I received Christ Jesus as Lord, I will continue to live in Him (Col. 2:6) I will be rooted and built up in Him, strengthened in the faith and overflowing with thankfulness. (Col. 2:7) I have been given fullness in Christ, the head over every power and authority (Col. 2:10) I died, and my life is now hidden with Christ in God. (Col. 3:3) I will give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for me in Christ (1 Thess. 5:18) • The name of our Lord Jesus will be glorified in me (2 Thess. 1:12) I have served well and will gain an excellent standing and great assurance in my faith in Christ Jesus. (1 Tim. 3:13) I will set an example for the believers in speech, in life, in love, in faith and in purity. (1 Tim. 4:12) • God, who richly provides for me everything for my enjoyment. (1 Tim. 6:17) • I have the promise of life that is in Christ Jesus, (2 Tim.1:1) • God has saved me and called me to a holy life because of his own purpose and grace (2 Tim. 1:9) I want to live a godly life in Christ Jesus and I will be persecuted (2 Tim. 3:12) • The Scriptures are able to make me wise for salvation through faith in Christ (2 Tim. 3:15) • I will be active in sharing my faith, so that I'll have a full understanding of every good thing I have in Christ (Philemon 1:6) I am a child of God, and I belong to Him (1 Pet.1:9) – I am redeemed by the precious blood of Christ (1 Pet.1:18-19) • Thru Him I believe in God, who raised Him from the dead and glorified him. My faith and hope are in God (1 Pet. 1:21) • I have been born again of incorruptible seed (1 Pet.1:23) • I trust in God and will never be put to shame. (1 Pet. 2:6) • I am a priest of God (1 Pet.2:5,9) The God of all grace, will Himself restore me, make me strong, firm and steadfast (1 Pet. 5:10) • I have fellowship with the Trinity (1 John 1:3) • I am in Christ and have no darkness in me. (1 John 1:5) • But when I walk in the light, as He is in the light, I have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, His Son, purifies me from all sin (1 John 1:7) • Christ is my advocate (1 John 2:1) Because I claim to live in Him, I must walk as Jesus did. (1 John 2:6) I don't love the world and I have the Father's love in me. (1 John 2:15) The anointing I received from God remains in me (1 John 2:27) I will continue in Him, so that when he appears I'll be confident and unashamed before Him at his coming (1 John 2:28) • I am a child of God (1 John 3:1) • He appeared so that he might take away my sins. And in Him is no sin. (1 John 3:5) • I am born of God and I will discontinue to sin, because God's seed remains in me (1 John 3:9) • I know that I live in Him and He in me, because He has given me of His Spirit. (1 John 4:13) • I acknowledge that Jesus is the Son of God, so God lives in me and I in God. (1 John 4:15) I know Him who is true. And I am in Him who is true—even in His Son Jesus Christ. He is the true God and eternal life. (1 John 5:20)
