<u>John 1:1</u> In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <u>Hebrews 1:8</u> But of the Son he says, "Your throne, O God, is forever and ever, the scepter of uprightness is the scepter of your kingdom.

<u>Isaiah 9:6</u> For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

<u>Matthew 4:10</u> Then Jesus said to him, "Be gone, Satan! For it is written, "'You shall worship the Lord your God and him only shall you serve.'"

Hosea 11:1 When Israel was a child, I loved him, and out of Egypt I called my son.

<u>Jeremiah 10:12</u> It is he who made the earth by his power, who established the world by his wisdom, and by his understanding stretched out the heavens.

<u>Isaiah 42:8</u> I am the LORD; that is my name; my glory I give to no other, nor my praise to carved idols.

Isaiah 26:4 Trust in the LORD forever, for the LORD GOD is an everlasting rock.

<u>Proverbs 30:4</u> Who has ascended to heaven and come down? Who has gathered the wind in his fists? Who has wrapped up the waters in a garment? Who has established all the ends of the earth? What is his name, and what is his son's name? Surely you know!

<u>Genesis 1:1</u> In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.

<u>Revelation 11:17</u> Saying, "We give thanks to you, Lord God Almighty, who is and who was, for you have taken your great power and begun to reign.

<u>Revelation 1:6</u> And made us a kingdom, priests to his God and Father, to him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

<u>Jude 1:25</u> To the only God, our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, dominion, and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen.

<u>1 John 5:20</u> And we know that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding, so that we may know him who is true; and we are in him who is true, in his Son Jesus Christ. He is the true God and eternal life.

<u>1 John 4:14</u> And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent his Son to be the Savior of the world.

<u>1 John 2:1-29</u> My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world. And by this we know that we have come to know him, if we keep his commandments. <u>James 1:17</u> Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change.

<u>James 1:13</u> Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am being tempted by God," for God cannot be tempted with evil, and he himself tempts no one.

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.

<u>Hebrews 2:9</u> But we see him who for a little while was made lower than the angels, namely Jesus, crowned with glory and honor because of the suffering of death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone.

<u>Hebrews 1:10</u> And, "You, Lord, laid the foundation of the earth in the beginning, and the heavens are the work of your hands;

<u>Hebrews 1:6</u> And again, when he brings the firstborn into the world, he says, "Let all God's angels worship him."

<u>Hebrews 1:2-3</u> But in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,

<u>Hebrews 1:1-14</u> Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, having become as much superior to angels as the name he has inherited is more excellent than theirs. For to which of the angels did God ever say, "You are my Son, today I have begotten you"? Or again, "I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son"? ...

<u>Titus 2:13</u> Waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,

<u>Titus 1:3</u> And at the proper time manifested in his word through the preaching with which I have been entrusted by the command of God our Savior;

<u>Titus 1:2</u> In hope of eternal life, which God, who never lies, promised before the ages began <u>1 Timothy 6:16</u> Who alone has immortality, who dwells in unapproachable light, whom no one has ever seen or can see. To him be honor and eternal dominion. Amen.

<u>1 Timothy 2:5</u> For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,

<u>2 Thessalonians 2:16</u> Now may our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God our Father, who loved us and gave us eternal comfort and good hope through grace,

<u>2 Thessalonians 1:1-12</u> Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. We ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers, as is right, because your faith is growing abundantly, and the love of every one of you for one another is increasing. Therefore we ourselves boast about you in the churches of God for your steadfastness and faith in all your persecutions and in the afflictions that you are enduring. This is evidence of the righteous judgment of God, that you may be considered worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you are also suffering— …

<u>1 Thessalonians 3:13</u> So that he may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father, at the coming of our Lord Jesus with all his saints.

<u>Colossians 1:16</u> For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him.

<u>Philippians 2:11</u> And every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

<u>Ephesians 2:18</u> For through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father.

<u>Ephesians 1:3</u> Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places,

<u>Galatians 4:6</u> And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!"

<u>Galatians 3:20</u> Now an intermediary implies more than one, but God is one.

<u>2 Corinthians 13:14</u> The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

<u>2 Corinthians 13:4</u> For he was crucified in weakness, but lives by the power of God. For we also are weak in him, but in dealing with you we will live with him by the power of God.

<u>1 Corinthians 10:4</u> And all drank the same spiritual drink. For they drank from the spiritual Rock that followed them, and the Rock was Christ.

<u>1 Corinthians 6:14</u> And God raised the Lord and will also raise us up by his power.

<u>Romans 1:7</u> To all those in Rome who are loved by God and called to be saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

<u>1 Corinthians 2:1-16</u> And I, when I came to you, brothers, did not come proclaiming to you the testimony of God with lofty speech or wisdom. For I decided to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ and him crucified. And I was with you in weakness and in fear and much trembling, and my speech and my message were not in plausible words of wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, so that your faith might not rest in the wisdom of men but in the power of God. ...

Acts 20:28 Pay careful attention to yourselves and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to care for the church of God, which he obtained with his own blood.

John 20:31 But these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

John 17:5 And now, Father, glorify me in your own presence with the glory that I had with you before the world existed.

<u>John 15:26</u> "But when the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, he will bear witness about me.

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

John 13:31 When he had gone out, Jesus said, "Now is the Son of Man glorified, and God is glorified in him.

<u>John 6:62</u> Then what if you were to see the Son of Man ascending to where he was before? <u>John 6:27</u> Do not work for the food that perishes, but for the food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give to you. For on him God the Father has set his seal."

John 5:1-47 After this there was a feast of the Jews, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem. Now there is in Jerusalem by the Sheep Gate a pool, in Aramaic called Bethesda, which has five roofed colonnades. In these lay a multitude of invalids—blind, lame, and paralyzed. One man was there who had been an invalid for thirty-eight years. When Jesus saw him lying there and knew that he had already been there a long time, he said to him, "Do you want to be healed?" ...

<u>John 3:16</u> "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

<u>John 3:13</u> No one has ascended into heaven except he who descended from heaven, the Son of Man.

John 3:1-36 Now there was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews. This man came to Jesus by night and said to him, "Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher come from God, for no one can do these signs that you do unless God is with him." Jesus answered him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God." Nicodemus said to him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?" Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. ...

Luke 2:11 For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.

Mark 12:29 Jesus answered, "The most important is, 'Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one.

<u>Mark 8:38</u> For whoever is ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, of him will the Son of Man also be ashamed when he comes in the glory of his Father with the holy angels."

<u>Matthew 28:18</u> And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.

<u>Matthew 19:26</u> But Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."

<u>Matthew 16:27</u> For the Son of Man is going to come with his angels in the glory of his Father, and then he will repay each person according to what he has done.

Matthew 6:8 Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him.
